




## The 1973 BSA Victor 500 MX (B50MX)

the crate. Powered by a big 499cc single, it has huge low end torque for flexible off-road performance.


There's a special racing frame, designed for competition. And the ingenious oil-inframe design distributes the weight evenly and eliminates the need for a separate oil tank.
